- I. Contrast to study of the Historical books of the Old Testament
  - A. Historical books: We glean truth from history and our observations of God working through events and people
  - B. Didactic literature—manual - like to be ingested for teaching guidelines, principles, and directives



# Galatians: Overview

Illustration: in the Old Testament we “drill” on events where as we “pan” for nuggets in the New Testament — the more intentional we pursue the more treasures we discover.
